You can visit or stay at Hollybank for a short break.



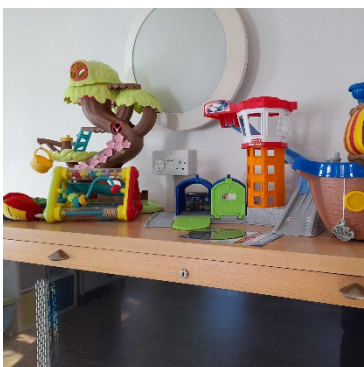
We have outside space with swings.

We have bedrooms you can sleep in.



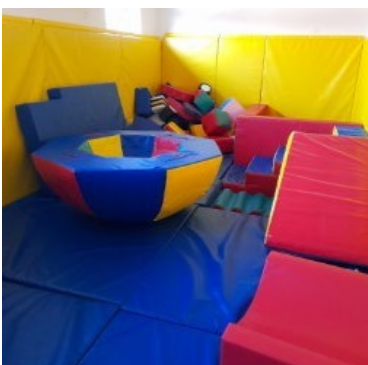
We have a craft room and activities you can do.

Bring your suitcase, have fun and relax with us.

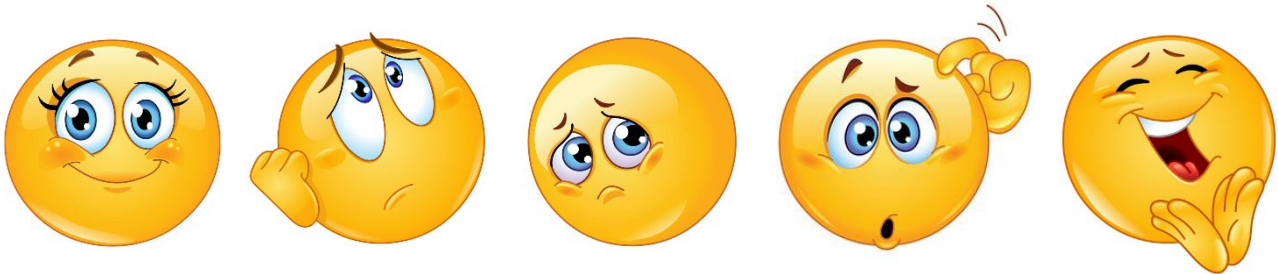


You can make new friends.
