**Emergency bed - to help
you in those difficult times**

If you're the parent or carer of a disabled child, it's possible that you live with the anxiety of what would happen to your child if suddenly you were unable to provide for them.

Unlike siblings who might be cared for by family and friends, your disabled child can remain vulnerable at such times owing to their additional and complex care needs or need for adapted accommodation.

What is Hollybank?

Hollybank is a short break setting for children with disabilities age 5-17 who can stay overnight for an allocated number of nights per month, or during the day at weekends and school holidays.

We have two units – the 'Poppy' unit has five beds and the 'Sunshine' unit has six beds.

We have excellent facilities to support your child whatever type of disability they may have.

Hollybank can offer an emergency bed for your disabled child if they have a similar profile to those children who already come here for short breaks - it's not only for children already known to us at Hollybank.

Our emergency bed is a separate facility within our Sunshine unit.

Depending on your child's need, the room can be discreetly separated from the rest of the bedrooms in the Sunshine unit.

This enables the emergency bed to be used by children if they have challenging behaviour, whilst maintaining the safety of the other children with complex medical needs at Hollybank.

Our staff

Our staff are fully trained and experienced in working with children and young people with disabilities.

As a team we have many years of experience of looking after children with disabilities, so you can be assured we will look after your child and ensure they're safe and well cared for.

Your child

We will do everything we can to comfort your child if they are unhappy.

If your child won't eat or drink we will try and tempt them with other choices. We're used to managing children with different dietary needs.

If your child has specific dietary needs we will work with you to make sure we give them what they need.

If your child doesn't sleep well, our staff will sit with your child and read them a story.

We will encourage your child to stay in their room to develop an improved sleeping pattern.

When your child is here with us at Hollybank, we have lots of things they can do including; arts and crafts, sensory room, soft play room, internet café, play station and Wii.
